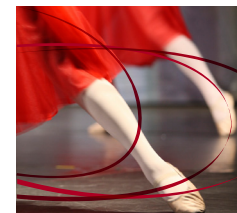


## **Wayne Lundberg** **Sunday** **January 29, 2012** **4:00 p.m.** **Sanctuary**
